- ◆ Combining Texture and Collage

IF THERE IS TIME, we will learn to use

- ◆ Use various tools, — straws, air compressor, canned air, hair dryer and an air puff-er blower (these will be available in class for your use)
- ◆ The difference between Tim Holtz Snow Cap and Pinata Blanco. Both of these are whites but have different effects/applications and
- ◆ Use these whites on black substrate. You will also work with other substrates which optimize the jewel tones of Alcohol Inks.

Alcohol Inks may be one of the most difficult mediums to learn how to use and to produce realistic paintings but it can be done. There just seems to be more steps in mastering this new and exciting medium. The next step in this class series will be to work toward realistic or representational work.
