Some of you have worked on Yupo in Alcohol Ink Classes. To others it will be a new and challenging experience. Yupo is a waterproof synthetic paper with a very silky surface and paint tends to flow and blend, as if it has a mind of its own. While you will start with this freedom, “Catching the Wave” and then you will quickly move on to painting traditional representational art similar to “Red Riot”.



Bring photographs that you wish to paint. Pixabay, Pixdaus and many others have royalty free reference materials. Pat will also bring many reference materials which you can use.

You will also learn how to seal your painting so that they do not have to be framed under glass and how to mount your works of art on cradle board which can be done instead of framing.

This is a s fun, different, and a little challenging, but the outcome is worth it! Yet another technique to add to your art portfolio!
