The Beginning Oil 3-day Workshop centers around the basics of composition, value, and color. We will work on these concepts while creating a beautiful still life. Each student is encouraged to bring an item that they would like to paint for their study. There will be additional items available if needed. Nicole will show her process of beginning with a Brunaille and then how to layer over this with color. This is a great introduction to oil painting and emphasis is placed on how to develop a strong foundation for realistic work.
