We will discuss how to achieve different textures within the painting including, glass, metal, and fabric. Please bring 2-5 objects to paint from. This class will arrange a more complex still life with your items and light them to get the most dynamic composition. Nicole will do a demonstration combining her beginning stages of an indirect painting and how to use many layers of color to build up a rich and detailed painting. We will work on many skills and techniques to bring your painting to completion with a more in depth look into creating convincing shadows, edge work, glazing, and highlights. This a great class for someone with a little experience in painting or drawing but all levels are welcome.



Nicole Hamilton is a fine artist who paints classical still lifes and portraits in oil. Her dedication to traditional techniques can be seen in the timeless elegance of her work.
